## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- (1) Tianjin Foreign Studies University (TFSU), one of China's eight foremost higher education institutions specializing in foreign languages, is a multidisciplinary university with "Foreign Language & Literature" as the predominant discipline.
- (2) The current program is a Chinese language and culture learning program designated for +students from Mediterranean coastal countries (i.e. Greece, Cyprus, and Italy).
